

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Our Company is committed to providing an adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities, both for our employees and those affected by the work that we carry out.

We will provide adequate resources to enable us to develop and use suitable safety management.

These will include:-

- 1) assessing and managing risks
- 2) maintaining a safe and healthy workplace, safe systems and methods of work and safe equipment
- 3) taking account of H & S issues and providing information, particularly on electrical safety, for the end-user of electrical Equipment and Appliances which we have inspected and tested.
- 4) providing staff with the information, instructions, training and supervision they need to work competently and safely
- 5) making staff aware of their individual responsibilities to take reasonable care for the safety of themselves and others and to co-operate with the management in matters of safety
- 6) encouraging full and effective consultation with all staff on safety matters

Our general H & S arrangements are set out in the following sections of this Health and Safety Policy Document, and its appendices. These will be amplified by supporting documentation as appropriate.

Every employee must read and follow the instructions and guidance in this Policy Document.

All our staff has an important role to play in helping to achieve the policy aims and objectives by:-

- acting responsibly
- having due regard to their own H & S
- considering other peoples' H & S

Subcontractors and sub consultants will be required to perform in a similar manner, so that the requirements of their own H & S Policy and our H & S Policy are necessary, and at least on a regular annual basis.
